Important: Please choose your days carefully. Any days that are requested on your booking sheet will be charged to your account, regardless of attendance. We cannot change your days if your child is unable to attend.

- ♦ **Fees will be charged weekly and in arrears. Fees will be direct debited from your nominated Credit Card.**
- ♦ To claim Child Care benefit a customer reference number will need to be provided.
- ♦ Only prescribed medications accompanied by a letter from your child's doctor will be administered. All medication must be handed to a caregiver and a medication authorization form must be completed. (This includes Asthma medication also)
- ♦ In case of unpredictable weather some activities/excursions may change without notice.

- ♦ Please advise your child not to bring valuables or treasures from home (Including hand held computer games). We will not take responsibility for them if they are lost or damaged.
- ♦ Copies of the parent handbook are available from the office to be taken home to read. The handbook includes some of the policies and procedures of the centre.
- ♦ PLEASE NOTE: No mobile phones are allowed. We have a mobile for the centre's use if we need to contact you or you need to contact us.
- ♦ The centre opens at 7.00am and closes at 6.00pm. Late fees will be charged at a rate of \$1 per minute.
